During the summer, the Association has chosen to give our Assistant, Jennifer the summer off so she can spend time with her family. Please use pre-registration on the website so we can have parking and pool passes issued ahead of time. Office hours will continue to be 9:00 am to 2:00 pm. I am here on the property Monday—Friday, 8 am—4:30 pm and can be reached in the phone system at extension 1000.

PARKING PASSES— Temporary parking passes are issued for no more than 90 days.

LARGE VEHICLES - Please do not allow large vehicles in the court yard area. It puts wear and tear on the water main which is located under the 6672 side. In the past we have had ruptures and are trying to minimize vibration in the area.

SECURITY—Security is very important to the majority of owners here at the Sandarac. The Board of Directors recently added a rule that owners should notify the office of owner arrivals and departures. This policy is to better inform the office of Sandarac property occupancy.

KEY AUTHORIZATION— Please update key authorizations regularly with the office.

HURRICANE PROCEDURES—In the event of a tropical event, the office will close 24 hours in advance of the storm so staff may take care of their needs and evacuate if they choose. The staff priority is Association property first including pool furniture and concierge owner requests including closing hurricane shutters second. During Irma, the office was inundated with requests from owners before the storm with special requests and after the storm with owners asking how is my condo? Please keep in mind that there are a total of 181 owners (both Sandarac I and II) all calling with the same concerns. It's overwhelming.

During Irma, internet service was decent and we were able to get e-mail blasts out. Please check your email before calling. I have email on my phone and can respond quickly. After the storm cell phone service was spotty and our phone lines were up and down. The office was on voicemail only for several days which was frustrating for some. This year, we have added a page on our website for hurricane updates for owners as another outlet of communication. Keep in mind every storm is different so as we assess the property we will update the page accordingly. Please keep in mind, we are in crisis mode. Please be patient.

MAINTENANCE REMINDERS

Condo watch is very important. A lot of times we find issues, leaks, water heater issues, air conditioning issues, and toilets leaking. Please make sure someone is checking your condo regularly when you are not here and especially after a major tropical event.

RENOVATIONS

REMODELING CONDOS - If you are planning to do any remodels please fill out the Town of Fort Myers Beach Condominium Association Approval Form and submit it to the office.

CONTRACTORS - When you hire a contractor ... If they do any property damage to the Sandarac, you as the owner are responsible for its repair. Please make sure they check in with the office daily and be issued a valid parking pass. We must have liability insurance information on file in the office.

DUMPSTER PLACEMENT - We now have a stricter policy regarding dumpster placement. Dumpsters and dumpster trailers may only be placed in only two specific places on the property regardless of length of stay, even one day. No contractors can have dumpsters in the courtyard or at in the closest visitor parking spot closest to the unit. There is a designated spot on the northside of the visitors parking area and one on the southside parking area near the carwash. Contractors need to notify the office before placing the dumpster or dumpster trailer to get specific instructions on dumpster placement. No materials may be thrown from balconies to a dumpster. Elevator pads must be used during demo.

POD PLACEMENT - We have ordered signage. In the meantime, please contact the office for location placement. There is a updated parking map on page 6 of the newsletter.

GENERAL - We do not allow objects/materials of any type to be thrown from the second floor to a truck or dumpster trailer below. There is no work allowed on Sunday. Contractors must keep the condo front walkway clear of materials and debris and must be cleaned up immediately. No contractor may cut tile in the walkway areas. Elevator pads must be installed.

INSURANCE— Anyone doing work on the property, including for work hired by owners inside units, must have a copy of liability insurance and workman's comp on file with the office.


You may pay dues on the website with a credit card, debit card, or your U.S. bank account information. If you need your Centennial Bank information, please contact the office!
