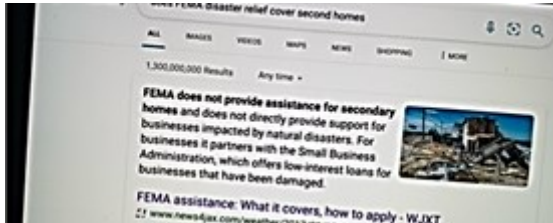


News

We learned the unfortunate news that FEMA does not extend aid if it is your 2nd home. Bob, Denise and Tom researched.

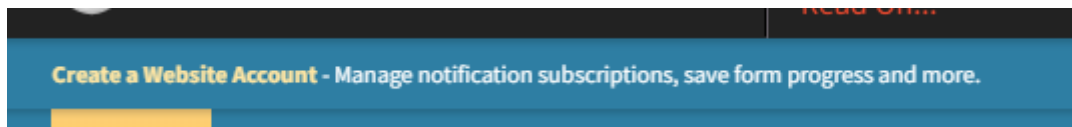


Getting Information

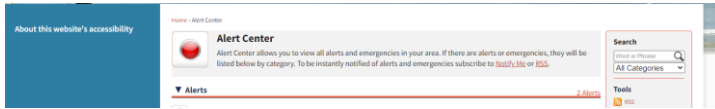
